CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- Pursuant to Section 14.A(6) of the Texas Securities Act, the foregoing violation 1. constitutes a basis for the issuance of an order reprimanding Respondent.
- 2. Pursuant to Section 23-1 of the Texas Securities Act, the foregoing violation constitutes a basis for the issuance of an order assessing an administrative fine against Respondent.

ORDER

- It is therefore ORDERED that the investment adviser registration of Charles Afton 1. Richards is hereby GRANTED.
- It is further ORDERED that Charles Afton Richards is hereby REPRIMANDED; 2.
- It is further ORDERED that Charles Afton Richards is hereby ASSESSED AN 3. ADMINISTRATIVE FINE in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00). Payment shall be made by delivery of a cashier's check to the Securities Commissioner in the amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00), payable to the State of Texas, contemporaneously with the delivery of this Order.


